

Student Responsibilities

Overview:

Students are reminded that they represent their respective schools in this countywide event. Considerate and courteous behavior is expected from all participants.

Specifically:

- **Be at the event no later than 5:45 pm. Find your chaperone and other team mates before reporting to your round one room.**
- Make sure the moderator and scorekeeper has the room ready before entering your round one room.
- Classroom displays, contents of desks, computers, etc. should never be touched.
- During each round, the team captain is responsible for either reciting the answer or designating a specific team member, by name, to answer the question. The team captain collaborates with other team members before giving an answer.
- When teams are made up of more than 12 students, alternates will be rotated in and out of each round. Note: All team members should participate in at least two rounds.
- Do not confer with opposing teams, the audience, or the team leader once a round has begun.
- Never argue with a moderator's decision. **The moderator's decision is final.**
- Whisper when traveling in the hallways. Other teams may still be in session.
- After each round, check for trash and deposit in proper receptacles.
- At the conclusion of round three, sit quietly in the room and wait for the presentation of ribbons.
- After the ribbons are presented, consider helping to put the classroom back to order with the guidance of the moderator and scorekeeper.
- Before you leave for the evening, make sure your chaperone knows you are being picked up by a parent or designated adult.
- On the ride home, take a moment to congratulate yourself no matter the color of ribbon you received.
